

**EXTENSION OF THE ORDER DECLARING A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY IN AND FOR
THE TOWN OF PARKER, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, C.R.S. § 24-33.5-701, *et seq.* (the "Act"), provides procedures for statewide and local prevention of, preparation for, response to, and recovery from disasters and emergencies;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, an "emergency" is an unexpected event that places life or property in danger and requires an immediate response through the use of state and community resources and procedures, and an "emergency epidemic" is cases of an illness or condition, communicable or noncommunicable, caused by bioterrorism, pandemic influenza, or novel and highly fatal infectious agents or biological toxins;

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709, a local disaster emergency may be declared "only by the principal executive officer of a political subdivision";

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Town of Parker Charter (the "Charter"), Section 15.14, Emergency Powers, the Town Administrator shall assume the authority to execute any action necessary for the protection of life and property to the extent allowed by ordinance;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Town of Parker Charter, Section 15.15, Continuity of Government, the Council shall have the power to provide for the continuity of government of the Town of Parker in the event of a natural or enemy caused disaster (or as otherwise declared in the Town of Parker Municipal Code, Section 2.03.020);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Town of Parker Municipal Code (the "Code"), Section 2.03.020, the Town Administrator may, in the event of an emergency, exercise complete administrative authority over any department, department head or Town employee and all Town-owned property. The Town Administrator shall determine when such emergency exists. may declare or proclaim a local emergency or unusual occurrence at which time the Town shall undertake appropriate responses;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Town of Parker Municipal Code, Section 2.03.020, the Town Administrator is delegated the authority within Sections 15.14 and 15.15 of the Charter to provide for the continuity of government and to provide for the necessary organization, powers and authority to enable the timely and effective use of all available Town resources to prepare for, respond to and recover from civil emergencies, emergencies or local disasters;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Town of Parker Municipal Code, Section 2.03.020, the Town Administrator is granted as broad a power as permitted within the Charter and the Town Council-Town Administrator form of government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(1), the declaration of a local emergency "shall not be continued or renewed for a period in excess of seven days except by or with the consent of [Town Council]";

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(1), any order “declaring, continuing, or terminating a local disaster emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the...[Town Clerk]...and with the office of emergency management”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(2), the effect of declaring a local disaster emergency “is to activate the response and recovery aspects of any and all applicable local and interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans and to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under such plans”;


WHEREAS, because of the COVID-19 pandemic, which occurred or began to occur on March 5, 2020, the Town of Parker is suffering or has suffered a disaster emergency or unusual occurrence as defined in the Act;

WHEREAS, the Town Administrator on March 13, 2020, did issue an Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker, Colorado, which Order expired on March 20, 2020, unless extended with the consent of the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the Town Council by Resolution 20-017, did consent to the extension or renewal of the Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker, Colorado, to a period in excess of seven (7) days as determined by the Town Administrator in her discretion.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, this 20th day of March, 2020, that the Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker, Colorado, is hereby extended beginning on this day and ending on a date to be determined by the Town Administrator in her discretion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Extension of the Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker, Colorado, shall be given prompt and general publicity, filed immediately with the Town Clerk, and a copy of it shall be sent to the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
