

EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 11-2020


ISSUED BY THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR

On March 13, 2020, the Town Administrator for the Town of Parker did issue an Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker (the "Emergency Declaration Order"). The Emergency Declaration Order is to be in effect until March 20, 2020, and consent has been obtained by the Parker Town Council to extend the Emergency Declaration Order to such time as the Town Administrator shall determine, in her discretion.

Pursuant to Section 15.14 of the Parker Town Charter, the Town Administrator shall assume the authority to execute any action necessary for the protection of life and property. Such authority may include but not be limited to establishing regulations governing conduct and activities related to the cause of the emergency.

Pursuant to the Town Administrator's above-stated authority, the Town Administrator issued Emergency Order No. 1-2020, which continued the Town of Parker Special Licensing Authority (the "Special Licensing Authority") meeting of Thursday March 19, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. to Thursday April 16, 2020. The purpose of this Emergency Order 11-2020 is to continue the rescheduled Special Licensing Authority meeting of April 16, 2020 at 6:30 p.m., to Thursday May 21, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. pursuant to this Order, because of the continuing difficulty in obtaining a quorum pursuant to Section 5.08.090 of the Parker Municipal Code. In addition, no matters currently scheduled for consideration by the Special Licensing Authority are time critical. Thus, all matters currently scheduled for the April 16, 2020 meeting shall be deemed continued to May 21, 2020, at 6:30 p.m.

This Emergency Order No. 11-2020 shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect until it is terminated or amended by the Town Administrator.
