

EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 21-2020

ISSUED BY THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR

On March 13, 2020, the Town Administrator for the Town of Parker did issue an Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker (the "Emergency Declaration Order"). The Emergency Declaration Order is to be in effect until March 20, 2020, and consent has been obtained by the Parker Town Council to extend the Emergency Declaration Order to such time as the Town Administrator shall determine, in her discretion.

Pursuant to Section 15.14 of the Parker Town Charter, the Town Administrator shall assume the authority to execute any action necessary for the protection of life and property. Such authority may include but not be limited to establishing regulations governing conduct and activities related to the cause of the emergency.

On June 5, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order D 2020 093, ordering the temporary suspension of C.R.S. Sections 44-3-103(38) and 44.3-301(3)(a) to allow for the modification of licensed premises to include communal outdoor dining area. The purpose of Town of Parker Emergency Order No. 21-2020 is to implement Executive Order D 2020 093. This Emergency Order shall allow two or more on-premises liquor licensees operating in accordance with Public Health Order 20-28 Safer at Home, as amended, to obtain temporary approval to modify their licensed premises to include a communal outdoor dining area that is within one thousand feet of each of their licensed premises.

This Emergency Order No. 21-2020 shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect through the duration of Executive Order D 2020 093, or until it is terminated or amended by the Town Administrator, whichever occurs first.
